Biosecurity Policy

1.0 Purpose

To establish minimum biosecurity practices to ensure a Worry-Free visit from the Service group to our customers.

2.0 Scope

Applies to the Service group.

4.0 Responsibility

Service Group – Consultants, Technicians, and all other Service staff, whether contract or permanent.

5.0 Procedure

5.1 *Poultry Withdrawal*

- 5.1.1 Respect and maintain all poultry withdrawal periods set out by the customer
- 5.1.2 Minimum 24 hour withdrawal from poultry in all cases, except where a specific exemption has been granted by the customer effected
- 5.1.3 Withdrawal from poultry to include:
 - 5.1.3.1 No contact with poultry during the period, including small personal flocks and locations where personal flocks may be (i.e. agricultural fairs)
 - 5.1.3.2 No contact with wild poultry, specifically turkeys, or areas where they frequent during this period
 - 5.1.3.3 No contact with migratory waterfowl or areas they frequent during this time period

5.2 *Personnel Actions at a Customer Site*

- 5.2.1 Wash hands when entering a customer site; use sanitizer if provided
- 5.2.2 Use boot wash or foot bath stations when passed by
- 5.2.3 Maintain workflow from clean to dirty (incubation to hatch) sides of hatchery as much as possible, preventing cross back
- 5.2.4 Avoid in-operation areas as much as possible
- 5.2.5 Follow all site biosecurity procedures (i.e. boot wash, hand sanitizer, hair nets, shower in/out, dress codes, etc).

5.3 *Personnel Actions Between Sites*

- 5.3.1 Wash all clothing between sites
 - 5.3.1.1 Where this is not possible, segregate clean and worn clothing in separate bags
- 5.3.2 Shower between site visits
- 5.3.3 Wash and disinfect boots with Lysol spray between sites
- 5.3.4 Wash vehicles between sites, spray tires and wheel wells with Lysol spray
- 5.3.5 Maintain withdrawal from poultry and migratory waterfowl

5.4 *Actions Pertaining to Tools and Equipment*

- 5.4.1 Ensure all job boxes and personal tools are free from organic debris at all times
- 5.4.2 Wash and Lysol any tools that may have been exposed to contamination
- 5.4.3 Option: maintain two sets of tools
