The world's largest breeder suppliers recommend S.P.I.D.E.S. (Short Periods of Incubation During Egg Storage)

When you need to store eggs for longer than 7 days, experts recommend using heat treatment during storage to improve the hatchability of your egg batch.

These special profiles prevent increased incubation time and will temper the effects on post-hatch performance.

All Jamesway machines are designed to operate as S.P.I.D.E.S. machines.

Using our regular machines you can create profiles which increase and decrease temperatures as required, keeping the embryos vital until they are inside the incubator.

How it works

- Fertile eggs that are stored for a longer period of time are transferred in Jamesway racks from the egg holding room to the S.P.I.D.E.S. incubator
- There is a gradual warming-up of these eggs from egg holding room temperature to a precisely controlled warmer temperature
- This temperature is sustained over several hours and then gradually lowered again
- The process is repeated as required until the eggs can be transferred into the incubator.
